Celebrating diversity is to understand that each individual is unique. Differences of race, ethnicity, gender, sexual orientation, socio-economic status, age, physical abilities, religious beliefs, political beliefs, or other ideologies makes us individuals. It is about understanding each other and moving beyond simple tolerance to embracing and celebrating the rich dimensions of diversity contained within each person.

The American Embassy in Budapest is sponsoring the second annual **Tolerance Video Competition** to highlight the importance of celebrating diversity. High school students in Hungary are invited to submit a short video clip on YouTube that captures the message of celebrating diversity in a creative, imaginative, and thought-provoking way. Finalists will be invited to an awards ceremony in Budapest in April 2010.

INSTRUCTIONS

- Create a YouTube video with an original and creative message about diversity;
- Videos must not be more than 30 seconds in length;
- Videos can be in English or Hungarian, but words are not required;
- To be eligible, participants must be enrolled in a Hungarian high school;
- Individual and team submissions will be accepted. However, only one prize will be awarded for each finalist;
